
## **Net Setup Instructions**



- 1. The net has two long ropes going through itself
  - a. One at the top (Blue), one at the bottom (Purple).
  - b. For each; one side should be short, the other should be long. All ends with 1 loop.

**HOW TO TIE A LOOP KNOT** 

- 2. Attach the net's top rope's short-side loop to the pole's upper top hook (upper hook for men's/open, lower for women's).
- 3. On the top rope's long side, thread the rope around the pole's top hook, then down and around the bottom hook.
- 4. Hold the loose loop. (there may be a long extra span of rope)
  - a. If a loop does not exist, tie one
  - b. If a knot exists in the wrong spot, pliers are available to aid in untying a knot.
- 5. Attach the top hook of the tie-down to the top hook.
- 6. Attach the bottom hook of tie-down to the loose loop of the net rope from step 4.
- 7. Pull the loose end of the tie-down to tighten the system.
- 8. Follow the same process for the net's bottom rope, but in reverse.
- 9. Tie the three side ropes to the pole like shoelaces.
  - a. If there is only one loose end, adjust the rope so there are two loose ends.
  - b. Pliers are available to aid in untying a knot.
- 10. The Four stakes and tie-down assemblies should be stored in the canvas zipper bag.
