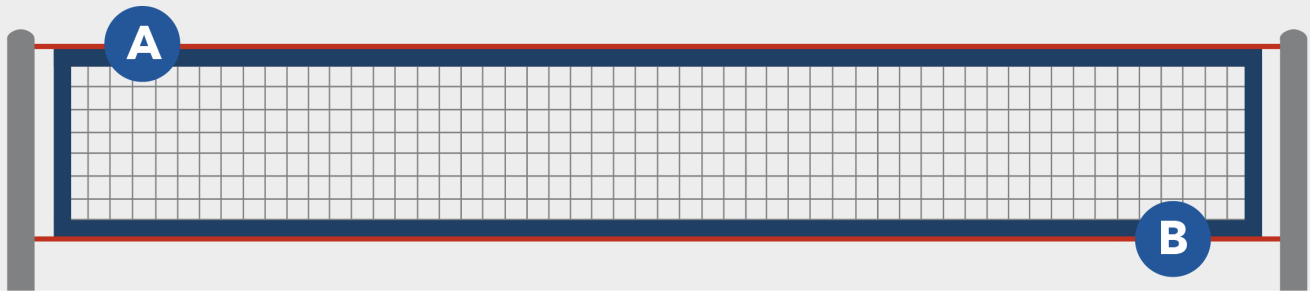
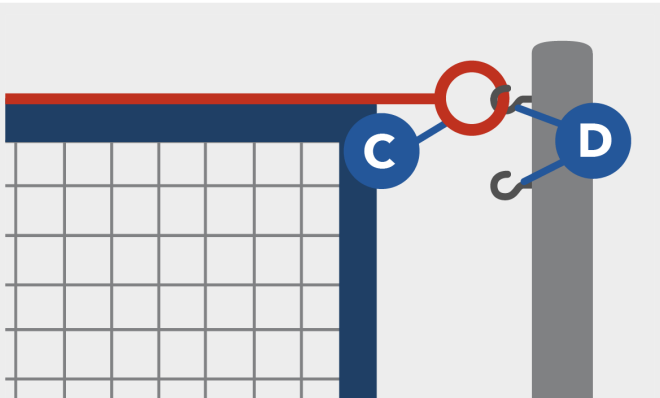


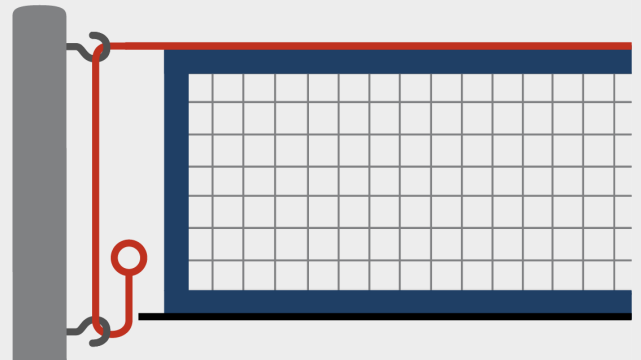
Net Setup Instructions



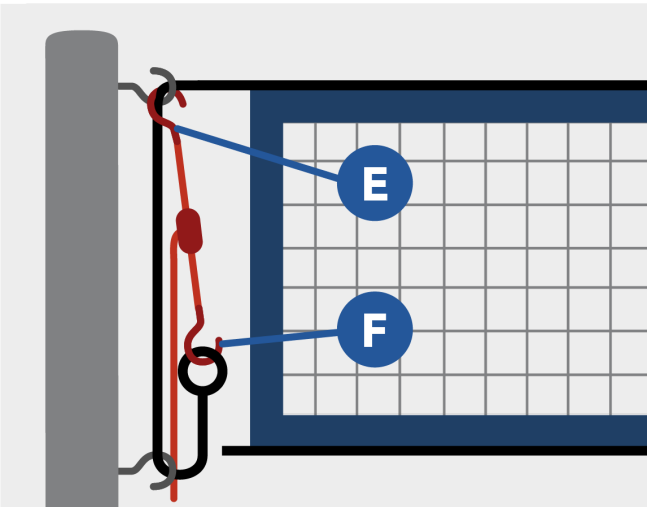
- 1** The net has two long ropes going through itself.
Top rope **A**
Bottom rope **B**
For each, one side should be short, the other should be long. All ends with a loop.



- 2** Attach the net's top rope short-side loop **C** to the pole's upper hook **D** (*Upper hook for Men's / Open, lower hook for Women's*).

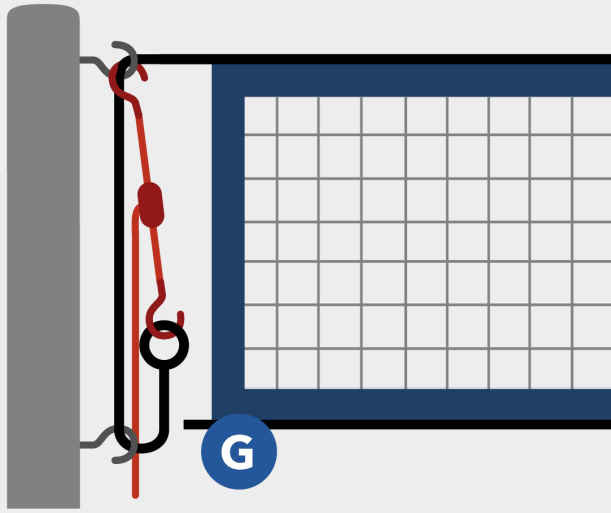


- 3** On the top rope's long side, thread the rope around the pole's top hook, then down and around the bottom hook.



- 4** Hold the loose loop. (there may be a long extra span of rope)
If a loop does not exist or is in the wrong spot, find a CMSA staff.
Attach the top hook of the strap **E** to the top hook.
Attach the bottom hook of the strap **F** to the loose loop of the net rope.

5 Pull the loose end of the strap to **G** tighten the system for the top rope of the net.



6 Repeat steps 2-5 for the net's bottom rope, but in reverse. Attach the net's bottom rope short side loop to the pole's bottom side.

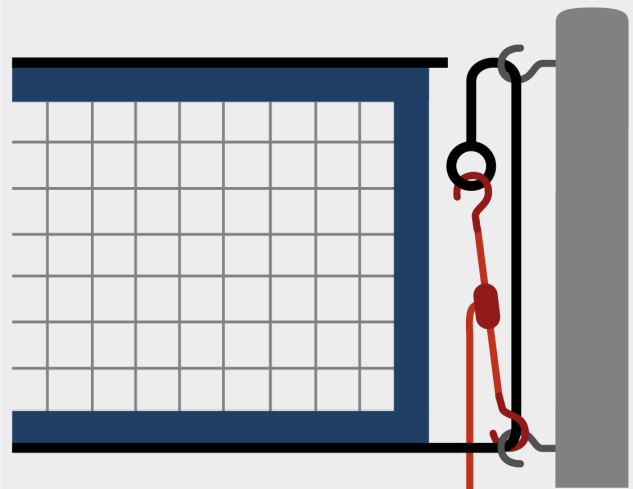
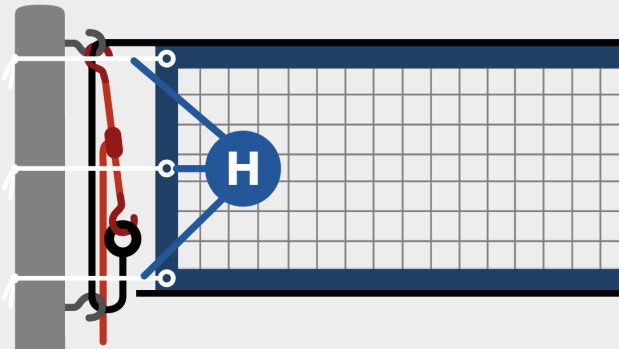


Wrap the bottom rope's long side around the pole's bottom hook and up towards the top.

Attach the bottom hook of the strap (f) to the pole bottom hook.

Attach the top hook of the tie-down to the loose loop of the net rope.

7 Tie the three side ropes **H** to the pole like shoelaces. (black or white ropes)



Takedown



8 Pinch/push the buckle on the tie-down strap to release the tension of the strap, so the ropes are loose enough to take off the pole hooks.



9 The four line stakes and the tie-down straps should be stored in the small white/red canvas zipper bag.
